CAES9540 Technical English for Civil Engineering:

offered in the FIRST semester for Year 4 students in BEng(CivE) & BEng(EngSc) Environmental Engineering

CAES9541 Technical English for Electrical and Computer Engineering:

offered in the SECOND semester for Year 4 students in BEng(CE), BEng(EE), BEng(ElecE), BEng(EngSc) Energy Engineering, BEng(EngSc) Systems Analytics & BEng(EngSc) Healthcare Engineering

CAES9542 Technical English for Computer Science:

offered in the FIRST semester for Year 4 students in BSc(FinTech), BEng(CompSc) & BEng(DS&E)

CAES9545 Technical English for Data and Systems Engineering:

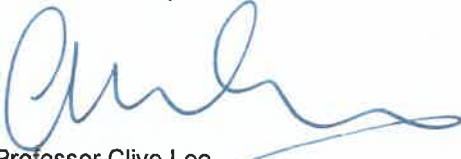
offered in the SECOND semester for Year 4 students in BEng(DASE)

You need to select a class during the course enrollment period (i.e. August 4 (12:00nn) (for Year-3 students) / (10:00am) (for Year-4 or above students) – August 10 (4:00pm), 2026). Starting from August 5, 2026 (9:00am), the SIS system will approve students by auto-balloting. You have to check your class selection result soon after the suspension period (i.e. August 5, 2026 (2:30pm)) and if you are not approved to take the class you have selected, you should choose another available class in SIS until you are given a place in a class.

You can change your class freely during the add/drop period, but you should check your class selection result periodically. **You are required to attend lessons in the originally enrolled CAES class until your request for a change of class has been approved.**
